<u>A SPIRITUAL PILGRIMAGE</u> <u>IS SACRIFICE THE ANSWER?</u>

If someone knew the best way to do something and that something was an important part of your life, wouldn't you want to learn everything you coulc from that person? Most reasonable and rational people would say "yes." So, what would you say if I told you at this time when the divorce rate among Catholis is generally considered to be around 50 percent, there was a city on this planet with no divorces. Not less ,not half, not very few – none. You would want to know their secret.

Siroki-Brijeg is the city with no divorce. Located in Bosnia-Herzegovina, there 30,000 inhabitants and not a single recorded case of divorce in living memory.

For centuries these people were persecuted for their Catholic faith. Famine, war, cultural strife, and unending political upheaval stain almost every page of their history books. They have suffered. And through that suffering they have learned an epic lesson: sacrifice and salvation are snseparably connected.

<u>Lesson:</u> There is no love without sacrifice. The Cross is Jesus' ultimate teaching. It is the ultimate masterclass on love. Inject sacrifice into any relationship and allow the fruits of Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross to breathe new life into that relationship.
