A SPIRITUAL PILGRIMAGE EUCHARISTIC MIRACLES

Once upon a time there was a priest who was plagued with doubts about whether Jesus was truly present in the Eucharist, until one day. After that day he never again doubted that Jesus was truly present in the Eucharist.

This opening may make this sound like a story, but it is a true story and there are a hundred like it that have been recognized by the Church.

Even though he was filled with doubts about the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, the priesgt faithfully celebrated Mass every day in fulfillment of his vocation.

On this particular day, around the year 700, in Lanciano, Italy, this priest was celebrating Mass in a small church and as he said the Words of Consecration ("Take this, all of you, and eat of it, for this is my Body which will be given up for you.") the bread changed into living Flesh and the wine changed into Blood before his eyes.

The Miracle of Lanciano is just one of more than a hundred Eucharistic miracles that have been documented throughout the life of the Church.

LESSON: Great faith and great doubt often go hand in hand, especially when it comes to accepting that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. Ask Jesus to strengthen your faith in His True Pesence in the Eucharist until it is unshakable.

VIRTUE OF THE DAY: Awe: The virtue of awe is a profound respect and reverance for the source of all life. Contemplation of life, truth, beauty, goodness and the sheer power of God all nurture the virtue of awe.

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION: Jesus, I believe that You are truly present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist. Every day I long for more of You. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot receive You sacramentally at this moment, I invoite You to come and dwell in my heart. May this spiritual communion increase my desire for the Eucharist. You are the healer of my soul. The the blindness from my eyes, the deafness from my ears, the darkness from my mind, and the hardness from my heart. Fill me with the grace, wisdom, and courage to do Your will in all things. My Lord and my God, draw me close to You, nearer than ever before.
