FEAST OF THE BEHEADING OF JOHN THE BAPTIST AUGUST 29

In Catholicism, the beheading of John the Baptist is commemorated on August 29th as the Feast of the Beheading of Saint John the Baptist. This feast day remembers the martyrdom of John, who was beheaded at the order of King_Herod Antipas after Herodias, Herod's wife, sought revenge for John's public denunciation of their unlawful marriage. The event is described in the Gospels of Matthew and Mark

On this day, the universal Church marks the beheading of John the Baptist, who prepared the way for Jesus. As an adult, he lived as a hermit in the wilderness. After the Spirit inspired him, he went about preaching that the people should repent of their sins and be baptized in order to prepare for the Messiah.

Herod imprisoned John because he had condemned Herod for committing adultery by living with his brother's wife, Herodias.

At the celebration for Herod on his birthday, the daughter of Herodias danced for him, and Herod was so impressed that he said he would offer her anything she liked. She consulted with Herodias who told her to ask for the head of John the Baptist on a platter. Herod did not want to kill John for fear or what his followers might do, but because of his promise to the girl he could not refuse, and so John was beheaded.
